The ESL classes are held at the Queen Elizabeth II Seniors & Community Centre, Durlacher St on Friday afternoons during school terms by qualified volunteer teachers.

The festivals are free community cultural events to showcase multicultural music and entertainment accompanied by culinary and artistic experiences from around the world.

The Midwest Multicultural Association (MWMA) helps to promote and celebrate cultural exchange and understanding between Australians and other cultures. The MWMA provides assistance in developing social support networks and promotes social and recreational activities for members and migrants living in Geraldton and the Midwest Region

The Multicultural Concert is a low-cost ticketed event for all the family, held in the comfort of the Queens Park Theatre, Geraldton. The exhilarating concert is followed by a cultural afternoon tea in the foyer.

Other cultural events such as dinners will be held throughout the year to encourage the community to get to know each other.
